I am currently organizing my groups for the first semester of 2017. If you have a student(s) who you would like to refer to a group, please complete this form and return it to me by September 30th.

Counseling Groups – 30 minutes once a week for 6 weeks

Grief/Loss groups are for students who have recently experienced death in their families.

Anger Management/Conflict Resolution groups are for students who are negative leaders, bullies or have trouble getting along with others.

Study Skills groups are for students who have problems with organization, homework, and/or time management.

Changing Families groups are for children who have suffered a recent separation, divorce, or deployment.

Friendship groups are for children who appear withdrawn from others and/or have trouble making friends.

Girl Power groups are for girls who may be suffering from low self-esteem or are having difficulty getting along with other girls.

Self-Control groups are for students who have difficulty staying focused, are inattentive, and have difficulty staying on-task in the classroom.
