Re: R131-16 Volunteerism Compliance

To whom it may concern,

This memo is to certify that the following is true for Discovery Charter School:

- Students are not penalized (e.g. banned from extracurricular activities) if their parents do not volunteer,
- Continued enrollment or reentry is not based on parent volunteerism,
- Monetary donations are not required in lieu of volunteer hours,
- References to volunteering on our school's website include a statement that volunteering is not required of parents or families
- References to volunteering within a student/parent handbook include a statement that volunteering is not required of parents or families

We do not have an adopted fee policy as defined in the R131-16, Sec. 8. 1. A charter school shall not: (g) Adopt a fee policy unless the policy is approved by the sponsor of the charter school and contains a provision for the waiver of all fees for any pupil who qualifies to participate in a program for free or reduced-price meals, regardless of whether the charter school participates in the program for free or reduced-price meals under the National School Lunch Act or School Breakfast Program, as defined in NRS 387.0693 and 387.073, respectively.
